Project updates

- The ultrasound workforce paper was presented to the planned care board and given the go ahead to progress with the recommendations. As a result Gill has already been invited to both maternity and womens health groups in order to advise on the workforce needs and situation.
- The paper outlining the current radiologist workforce challenges was circulated and presented at the August DSOG meeting. Within this paper several other key projects were identified and it was requested that they are progressed. The financial assessment is almost complete and work on accurately mapping the reporting radiographer workforce is about to begin.
- The management and leadership project PID has been circulated to Imaging workforce and Education Transformation Group (IWETG) members for approval this month.
- All outputs for the Imaging Support Worker Group (ISWG) have now been completed and project closure documents circulated. The NIP would like to thank all stakeholders who have given their time and effort to successfully completing this project. Please see our Special Feature section below.
- All-Wales job descriptions for Radiology Clinical Support Workers at all Bands, along with those for Assistant Practitioners in both Screening Mammography and Radiography are available at [Allied Health Professions | NHS Confederation](#).
- A Project Initiation Document has been agreed to support work looking at the Enhanced, Advanced, and Consultant workforce within radiology services. This project will undertake similar actions to those within the ISWG, looking to clarify and agree definitions, role and educational

- The programme is awaiting steer for next steps regarding a Ministerial decision around accreditation and is developing the Business Case in anticipation of a decision.
 - There will be a meeting in late September in Welsh Government to discuss the quality plan for Wales.
- Constant contact and engagement with RcR/CoR.
- The Modality Quality Groups are moving forward and working well, with the below progress being made:
 - Successful meetings for the established Groups
 - Chairs nominated and agreed
 - A representative from the team will join the existing Nuclear Medicine group as an observer on December 6th.
 - The chairs of three of the modality groups have been invited to attend the All Wales Imaging Quality Forum (AWIQF), with one chair still to be finalised.
 - The AWIQF will assess the potential of establishing an Interventional Imaging Group commencing 2025.
 - Modality Quality Teams channels are being used well, it is a good tool for sharing resource and efficient conversations.
- Anatomical side markers guidance has been completed and will be taken to DSOG in October, following this it will move to Welsh Scientific Advisory Group for discussion and distribution if agreed.
- An All-Wales Non-Medical Referrer SBAR has been completed and will be taken to DSOG in October for discussion around next steps.

A total of 65 evaluation forms received, with 29 achieving the required initial risk score to be discussed at the Review Panel Meeting on 10th September 2024. Excellent engagement in the process, with forms submitted from all Health Boards and Trusts.

This is the first time All-Wales job descriptions have been produced for radiology services and was the result of significant collaboration between representatives from Radiology services, Breast Test Wales, Society of Radiographers, NIAW and HEIW. The National Imaging Programme would like to take this opportunity to again thank all involved for their hard work and dedication. Job descriptions for the following roles have been produced;

- Radiology Clinical Support Worker (Band 2)

The NIAW and HEIW have worked quickly to support this, working with Agored to create a new cannulation course for RCSWs and Radiographers to develop this skill. The first cohort of learners will be welcomed very shortly, and the NIP would like to thank the NIAW along with Patricia Mathias-Lloyd and Teresa Davies-Elvin from HEIW for all the hard work required to get this off the ground.
